

CREATIVE DETOURS SUPPLY LIST

CAMANO ISLAND QUILTERS

For this class you will need to purchase the pattern which I will bring to class....the fabric amounts are listed. The main thing to remember is to bring a collection of **theme** or scrap fabrics that appeals to you. Fat quarters work well, and large theme prints are great as well. The pattern can be easily adjusted to accommodate any fabric you choose. The largest block is 12 ½” square, so you can plan your fabric accordingly. The total amount of fabric you will use is a total of about 4 yards.

Other supplies in addition to the pattern.....sewing machine, coordinating thread, rotary cutter, ruler, mat....any other supplies you like to have with you at class.

OPTIONAL 6 1/2" square rulers work well for this project as well as 12 1/2" square rulers, too.

Border and lattice fabric can be purchased later if you wish. You get your top nearly finished in class.

NOTE....the size of this quilt is 60 by 60 inches....with no borders or sashing between the quadrants.

Be sure your fabric has a variety of lights, darks, different scale prints, and black and whites are fun, or some other “zingers? Some fabrics in large prints work well, as well as border prints for sashing and borders.....you will need a total of about 4 yards for your quilt top. ...bring plenty so you have a good pile from which to choose!

Check out the beautiful Australian or Kaffe Fasset fabric. (NOTE....I have made food themed quilts, African, Australian, Asian, polka dots, cowboy, and others.) I use any leftover fabric on the back of the quilt!
