Dutchman's Puzzle

Fabric: 4 different fabrics plus background

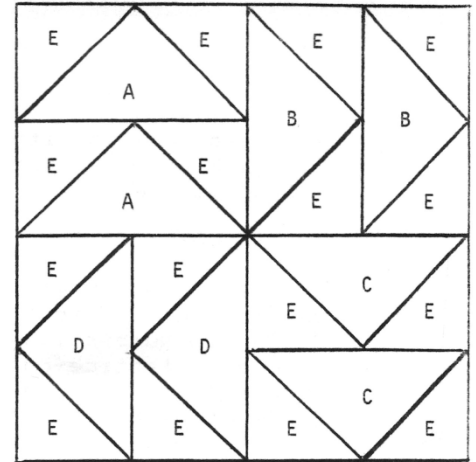
Cutting Directions: Cut (2) $4\frac{1}{4}$ " by 8" Color A

(2) $4\frac{1}{4}$ " by 8" Color B

(2) $4\frac{1}{4}$ " by 8" Color C

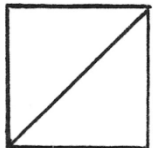
(2) $4\frac{1}{4}$ " by 8" Color D

(16) $4\frac{1}{4}$ " by $4\frac{1}{4}$ " Color E (background)



Sewing:

1. Draw a diagonal line on the back of each of the 16 Color E background pieces.
2. Place one of the $4\frac{1}{4}$ " Color E squares on one end of the Color A $4\frac{1}{4}$ " by 8" pieces, lining up the edges.
3. Sew ON the diagonal line.
4. Press the Color E triangle toward the outer corner of the Color A piece. DO NOT STRETCH. Trim the two under layers to a $\frac{1}{4}$ " seam allowance. Check to make sure piece is still EXACTLY $4\frac{1}{4}$ " by 8".
5. Repeat steps 1 through 4 using another $4\frac{1}{4}$ " Color E square and sew it to the other end of the same Color A $4\frac{1}{4}$ " by 8" piece.
6. Repeat steps 1 through 5 using all the $4\frac{1}{4}$ " by $4\frac{1}{4}$ " Color E squares and the other Color A, the two Color B, the two Color C, and the two Color D pieces.



Assembling the block:

Lay the eight pieces out in the correct order and sew. Make sure each pair of Flying Geese measures EXACTLY 8 inches by 8 inches. Block should be approximately $15\frac{1}{2}$ inches square, unfinished.
